

## Manitowoc County Property Transactions Involving Gottsackers

### **7 Jul 1857**

Sale of lot #12 Plat 91 owned by Henry Seinfonk (?) and wife Lydia to Sebastian Godsacker for \$150.00.

*Notes: This is Carl Gottsacker. His wife is Catherine Gergen.*

### **13 May 1859**

Mortgage for \$55.00 held by Charles S. Gottsacker and wife Catharine. Mortgagor is Joseph Gottsacker for lot # 12, block 91 in Two Rivers.

*Notes: Catherine signed the document 'Catharina'. This lot is the same purchased two years earlier by Carl for \$150.00. Joseph Gottsacker had arrived in 1855 and his wife Barbara and son Anton arrived in 1857.*

### **3 Dec 1860**

Mortgage for \$50.00 held by Franz Swaty and wife Josepha. Mortgagor is Charles Gottsacker of Fond du Lac County for lot #8, block 91 in Two Rivers.

*Notes: This is Carl Gottsacker again. The Swatys are from Ahnapee, in Kewaunee County. At the time, Two Rivers was the town nearest Ahnapee—about 25 miles south of Ahnapee.*

### **4 Jul 1864**

Mortgage for \$150.00 held by Franz Swaty and wife Josepha. Mortgagor is Joseph Godsacker of Two Rivers for lot #12, block 91 in Two Rivers. Mortgage does not include 24 feet of a portion of the lot which has been deeded to Joseph Godsacker previously. This mortgage is for a section of the lot 60 feet by 26 feet.

### **31 Aug 1880**

Satisfaction of mortgage dated 18 Oct 1877 and held by Peter Frey of Sheboygan County. Mortgagors were Joseph and Barbara Gottsacker of Manitowoc County.

*Notes: Peter Frey is or will become the son in law of Joseph and Barbara, marrying their daughter Marie.*

**31 Aug 1880**

Satisfaction of mortgage dated 1 Oct 1877 and held by August Trilling. Mortgagors were Joseph and Barbara Gottsacker. Peter Frey signed as a witness.

*Notes: August Trilling eventually moves to Sheboygan and opens a hardware store.*
